- The mini canteens will be abide by all the rules and regulations of concerned Master Canteen and open/function on the following terms and conditions:-
  - Arrangement of sufficient space for functioning of mini canteens by i)Ex-Para Military Association.
  - It will be responsibility of the Association to arrange initial fund for creating infrastructure and manning them. ii)
  - Concern Association has to be registered with State/Govt. of India.
  - At the proposed place of concerned canteen there should be five iii) hundred Ex-CAPF personnel residing in vicinity. iv)

- v) Two senior most Ex-officers/Officials of the concerned Association will submit personal Indemnity Bond and will be liable for any loss to concerned Master Canteen.
- vi) A minimum percentage of profit for such mini canteens may be decided by the Association which will be utilized to meet the cost of running of such canteens. Being a welfare measure it should not be a source of profit.
- vii) Such mini canteens will be functioning under direct supervision of Chairman of concerned Master Canteen. The Chairman/GM of concerned Master Canteen will also work as monitoring agency over the concerned mini canteens and define instruction/guidelines for monitoring and auditing the canteens time to time through various measures.
- viii) If it is found that the Association is indulging in any fraudulent/ pilferage activities or sale to unauthorized personnel, permission may be immediately cancelled.
